This program is available for Bachelor of **Music** and **Visual Communication (Design)** students who have completed 3 trimesters of their degree. Exceptions for students proficient in Spanish may apply; contact us for details.

Language Requirements

The recommended language level is B1-B2 of CEFR* to follow the classes, which are all taught in Spanish.

The classes are taught in Spanish and the student needs to embrace the challenge to manage classes in this language. The Institutional Department holds the right to interview the student during the selection process to prove the Spanish language skills.

Visas

Students coming from a country outside the European Union might need to apply for a Visa before coming to Spain. The student will have to present an Acceptance Letter issued by TAI in the Spanish Embassy in their home country.

Exchange students will be responsible for obtaining the necessary visas and abiding by all immigration laws and regulations of the host university's country. TAI will assist in such efforts but will have no responsibility for the issuance of visas, permits or approvals. Insurance

Students from non-EU Countries will be required to have a copy of their Health Insurance before their arrival to TAI.

Mentoring Program and Welcome Week

Before their arrival, exchange students will be approached by assigned TAI mentors, who will help them before and throughout their stay if they need assistance regarding the functioning of the school, classes, or life in Madrid.

In addition, the Institutional Department organizes a Welcome Week to guarantee the inclusion of the incoming students and their satisfactory incorporation at TAI and the academic, cultural and social life in Madrid.

In the first week of mobility, exchange students will be invited to several cultural activities and informed about all the rules and proceedings of TAI.
